Longarm Quilting services at Meadow Rose Quilts can be very straightforward and reasonably priced or more densely quilted with a variety of prices.

You will notice that I've given a range of prices for the different categories. This gives me the flexibility to quilt what you want and charge you accordingly.

When quilts are brought in for quilting, I will complete an intake form and give you a price quote. I try really hard not to exceed the price quote. Your signature on the bottom of the intake form gives me permission to work on your quilt to our agreed upon details.

Quilts can be pre-booked through a phone call or email conversation. All price quotes will be an estimate until I have looked carefully at the quilt layers and I have a customer's signature on the intake form.

It is important that your quilt borders be sewn correctly. A longarmers' nightmare can be borders that ripple and wave. This is caused by borders not being measured, cut and sewn correctly. There is a document on the web site that you can use as a guide for sewing perfect borders.

Make sure the quilt top and backing are pressed and all loose threads are clipped. The quilt batting and the backing should be approximately 10" longer and wider than the quilt top. i.e. 60" x 80" quilt top should have a backing that is approximately 70" x 90".

Quilting prices are based on the square inch measurement of your quilt. To find the square inch, multiply the length of the quilt in inches by the width of the quilt in inches to get the total area of the quilt.

Custom Quilting I: Basting Services include loading your quilt layers on the frame and stitching basting row 4-6" apart across the quilt to hold the layers together. Basting the quilt layers allows you to quilt your quilt on a stationary machine.

1-2¢ per square inch

Custom Quilting 2: Computerized Quilting using an Edge to Edge design. I have a selection of computerized designs to choose from.

Customers are welcome to discuss purchase of designs from other sources.

2.5-3.5¢ per square inch

Custom Quilting 3: Free hand quilting with an all over Edge to Edge design. Design will be chosen to coordinate with quilt top and customer consultation.

3-6¢ per square inch

Custom Quilting 4: Free hand quilting with specific patterns and/or thread changes. As discussed in the quilt consultation when the quilt is booked in.

5-7¢ per square inch

Custom Quilting 5: Medium to higher density quilting with free hand background fill and/ or detailed patterns. As discussed in the quilt consultation when the quilt is booked in.

6-9¢ per square inch

Other Services Available based on the outer perimeter of the quilt top.

Trimming: The quilt layers will be trimmed even with the edge of the quilt top in preparation for binding. All fabric trimmed away will be returned to the customer.

3¢ per linear inch

Binding 1: Prepare and sew the binding to the front of the quilt using customer supplied fabric*. I will cut binding strips and sew them together into 1 long strip before sewing to the quilt.

7¢ per linear inch

Binding 2: Prepare and sew binding to the back of the quilt using customer supplied fabric*. I will cut binding strips and sew them together into 1 long strip before sewing to the quilt then turn the binding to the front and machine stitch in place.

10¢ per linear inch

*Customer is responsible for providing sufficient fabric yardage for the binding.

Batting is available for purchase.

All prices include quilt loading and thread use.

I reserve the right to refuse any service or return any quilt to the customer for improper quilt construction or materials used.
